Greater Greenwood Arts Council Scholarship

Today's art, music and literary artists are tomorrow's leaders in the arts industries. The Greater Greenwood Arts Council is proud to invest in the future of all arts by awarding a one-time scholarship to help up to 3 promising students with rising tuition costs.

The Greater Greenwood Arts Council Scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior who is pursuing a degree in fine arts, arts education or an art related field from a college, university, or school of design, and will graduate from a Johnson County Indiana high school before July 1 of the year in which the scholarship will be awarded. GGAC will award three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$500 each to be paid directly to the college or university attended by the award winner. The scholarships will be awarded to individuals studying the following areas, one scholarship per area:

- 1. 2D/3D art or a related field
- 2. Performing arts (including dance, music, theater, and performance)
- 3. Literary arts or related field

The scholarship submission consists of a completed application form, portfolio, artist's statement, letter of recommendation and transcript. Applications are due no later than April 20, 2025.

- 2. Flash drive, CD, or Google Drive portfolio containing representation of your work (art, video performance or audio performance, or written works)

3. Artist's statement

4. Letter of recommendation

5. Transcript

Deadline: Please return this completed form along with your portfolio, application form, artist's statement, letter of recommendation and transcript by *April 20, 2025*, to **Greater Greenwood Arts Council, PO Box 1420, Greenwood, IN 46142, email:** <u>info@greenwoodarts.org</u> to be considered for the school year starting with the fall, 2025 semester.

Portfolio: The portfolio should include a **minimum of three (3) and a maximum of six (6)** labeled images of work, video or audio performances, or written works completed within the last 24 months. This work should demonstrate your ability and serious pursuit of your art and should represent the *diversity* of your experience. All work must be original unless demonstrating a performing art (cover of another work). The portfolio should be submitted digitally using high resolution jpg files, youtube videos or audio files via flash drive, CD or Google Drive. Label each item with your name, title and media using the following format:

Your Name_Title of submission_Type of media or performance

Submissions will not be returned.

Artist's Statement: The artist's statement should include your reasons for wanting to be an artist, an explanation of your creative process (where you get your ideas and how you get them to the final visual expression), and why you are seeking this scholarship.

Letter of Recommendation: A letter of recommendation from a current or past instructor familiar with your artistic qualifications should be included with the application.

Transcript: Copy of official transcript of high school credits.

Selection: Selection will be determined by the Greater Greenwood Arts Council scholarship committee after review of all information submitted with the application form. You will be contacted in late May with results.
